The Board noted that no Sign Permit application was received from 18 W State Rd. (The NOTT).

The Board noted that no Facade Permit application was received from 30 Quarterline Rd. (Ken Armour).

Rachael Porter, River Country Chamber of Commerce, said that the Christmas Walk is scheduled for Friday, December 5<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 pm-9:00 pm and that the road closure will begin shortly before 6:00 pm.

Fedell stated that the DPW plans to install felt on the band shell in Brooks Park, which may be decorated by students as an alternative to the tree in front of City Hall. Details are still being determined.

Goodin said that the lights on the tree in front of City Hall will go up and down but they will add more lights to the tree.

Board discussed the Christmas Music schedule and plans to keep the same schedule as last year.

Board discussed lighting the light posts and Slominski said that a few posts have been decorated with different brands of lights for testing to determine the best option. He said that he had communicated with Ron Wight, DPW Superintendent, and no adaptors would be needed and that the DPW will install the lights on the light posts. The Board estimated the cost of \$50-\$55 per light post for approximately 45 light posts. Cooper will contact Cronks Hardware to inquire about ordering the preferred type of lights. The plan is to finalize the light supplier by the end of the week and Board Members will contact other PSD members to ask for donations for the project. Fedell stated that the City will purchase the lights using funds from the PSD account and all donated funds will be reimbursed to the PSD account.
